

Sizing Information*

Sizing in cm is a height measurement, in mm it is the width of the main stem (often a larger tree)

100 cm = 3'+

150cm = 5' height

250 cm = 8'+ height

35 mm = typically 6-10' (depending on the tree)

50 mm = typically 10-14' (depending on the tree)
